Melanie Van Every, age 56, a life-long resident of Edinburg died Friday April 26, 2019 at the Mountain Valley Hospice House following a short illness. She was born in Gloversville, NY on December 15, 1962. The daughter of Leland C. and Ruth Colson Robinson. She was a graduate of Northville Central School.
